London-based band **the Magic Numbers**, **Lisa Hannigan** and a number of local groups will also play on the night. A Cork film programme will include a number of short films shot in the city. Tickets for the event are free, but you'll have to be over 18 and go through a selection process via www.littlebignightsout.com. Tickets went on sale yesterday for **Ne-Yo's** appearance at the O2 in Dublin on February 11. When it opens in March, the Grand Canal Theatre, owned by Harry Crosbie, will be another addition to capital's plethora of gig venues, and its capacity of 2,200 is ideal for many medium sized acts. Among those already booked to play the Daniel Libeskind-designed venue is **Randy Newman** on May 7. **Other Voices** will record its eighth series in St James's Church in Dingle from December 5-9 with BBC DJ **Annie Mac** presenting performances from the likes of **Snow Patrol**, **Richard Hawley**, **The XX** and **Imelda May**. About 60 tickets per night will be available to the public from tickets.ie on Monday. Tickets are also still available for **Arctic Monkeys'** appearance at the O2 next Thursday

and **Ian Brown's** visit to the INEC in Killarney next Friday. Former Fugazi bass player **Joe Lally** is at the Crane Lane in Cork on Sunday.
